School of Ministry: Lifegate Church Fast Track

The Apostolic mandate that LIFEGATE CHURCH expresses is through teachings on accountability, marketplace ministry and evangelism and classes on miracles and healing. Apostolic training involves not only teachings concerning apostolic authority and apostolic mandates but the need to establish godly order in every area of ministry and every-day living.

The school of ministry is a ten-month program that is taught in fast tracks. Each fast track is equivalent to one month of classroom attendance. Classroom participation is necessary to graduate. Each student is required to turn in all homework monthly and complete their reading assignments each month. Each student is trained in scripture with personal activations using their gifts of the Spirit. The main focus of the school is Word, prayer, prophecy, and healing. We are not called to be prophets, but we are called to hear His voice and celebrate His goodness.

The actual “activation” and “training” involves not only a biblical understanding of prophecy but also there is a prophetic release and impartation to prophesy. The School of Prophets is also designed to express the importance of godly character, accountability and biblical maturity as saints move forward in their gifts and talents.

Our school of ministry involves the students to enroll monthly or enroll for the entire year. Lifegate School of Ministry uses only the best books and materials to educate the student to use their particular gift and talent for the glory of our Lord. The school of ministry usually begins in March and ends in December. Classes include coming to the first Friday night service once a month and on the next day on Saturday, classroom participation is required now. Internet school of ministry will soon emerge.

However, until then, classroom attendance is required which starts on Saturday (following first Friday service) at 9:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. School graduation is in December for all who complete each class and complete all homework assignments.
